Its specific mandate according to the Act include the promotion of the health of the population of Zimbabwe; regulation, controlling and supervision of all matters affecting the training and practice of all Allied Health professionals, issuance of registration and practising certificates to allied health practitioners and to cancel or suspend such certificates in terms of the Act and to define and enforce ethical practice and discipline among allied health practitioners.

In pursuance of the above, the AHPCZ will be hosting the **Second Allied Health Practitioners Annual Conference in Harare on the 5th of October 2018**.
